The Maison Doucet Hennessy House is a cherished local historic site built by Charles Doucet, an enterprising Acadian refugee whose family established the first permanent European settlement at Nepisiguit (present-day Bathurst, New Brunswick) in 1781.

The Maison Doucet Hennessy House Association is currently in Phase Two of renovations with new walls, ceilings, electrical and plumbing, as well as an accessible washroom on the first floor. Plans to develop the rest of the building for community cultural space, social enterprise and two housing units aimed at low to moderate income earners are its priority now, along with a focus on solar energy to improve energy efficiency and reduce its carbon footprint.
